Booking Information:

- The Vacation Care Program may be subject to change without notice due to circumstances beyond the control of Torrensville Primary School OSHC.
- Families must not have outstanding OSHC fees to access Vacation Care.
- All bookings must be paid via direct debit the following week of care.
- Vacation Care is subject to availability and staffing arrangements.
- Families can apply for Child Care Subsidy discount by registering through My Gov.

Cancellation:

- No cancellations are permitted during Vacation Care, all unattended bookings will be noted as absent.
- Swapping days **before the holiday period is permitted until Monday 30/03/2026.** Please email to arrange swapped days: DL.1285.oshc@schools.sa.edu.au (*conditions apply*).

Key Information

Food and Drink:

- Please pack a healthy recess, lunch, snacks and water bottle each day.
- Allergies at OSHC - Please do not send nuts or foods containing nuts (**we are nut free**).
- Breakfast is available each morning between 7:30am-8:20am.
- Afternoon tea is served each day between 3:00pm-4:30pm.

Clothing, Footwear and Sun Protection:

- Please ensure children are dressed in appropriate clothing, sun smart on warmer days shirts or dresses with sleeves (no singlets,) jumpers and jackets on cold and rainy days.
- Please ensure children wear appropriate footwear (no thongs, crocs or slides).
- Children are required wear a hat each day, legionaries or wide brimmed. (caps are not an acceptable sun smart hat).
- OSHC provides 50+ sunscreen for children. If you require a specific type of sunscreen please supply it each day.
- Families are asked to apply sunscreen to children prior to arriving at OSHC.
- Please pack a spare change of clothes and shoes for play in the event of an accident.
- All aquatics excursions require children to be sun smart, wearing a t-shirt or rashie top over bathers is expected for all outdoor aquatic activities.
- Ensure all clothing is named and labelled.

Excursions, Transport and Safety:

- The bus company we use has seatbelts, all children and educators are required by law to wear them.
- Excursion departure times are specified on the program.
- Excursions may include lunch and play at a local park after programmed activity.
- Children will be back to OSHC for afternoon tea between 3:30pm-4:30pm, unless specified on the program.
- Risk assessments available at OSHC.
- All chartered buses are fitted with seatbelts.
